

## Mary Baldwin College Notification Policy

At Mary Baldwin College we are committed to the emotional and physical well-being of each of our students. In addition, we recognize the importance of maintaining a healthy and stable environment for the entire MBC community. As a result, we encourage students to maintain open communication with MBC staff regarding any concerns or needs.

In our commitment to best serve student interests and the entire MBC community, we may deem it necessary to disclose certain information to other campus and off-campus professionals [i.e., emergency room staff], as well as to a parent/guardian. The conditions which lead to notification of others include the following:

- Hospital care for medical or emotional reasons.
- Threats or behaviors that may result in harm to self or others.
- Report that a student is missing from campus raising concern for that student's personal safety.
- Arrest of a student or reports that a student is engaging in illegal activity.

This agreement for notification will be valid during a student's enrollment at Mary Baldwin College.
