Freshmen who apply to Mary Baldwin College with particularly strong academic records are encouraged to apply for entrance into the College's Global Honors Scholars Program. To be considered for this distinction, you should submit an application and are strongly encouraged to participate in an on-campus interview with a member of the Global Honors Scholars Committee. Students admitted to the program typically have SAT scores above 1700 and high school GPAs above 3.5.

The Mary Baldwin College Global Honors Scholars Program allows students to increase the depth and breadth of their academic experience as they pursue creative and engaging research projects, participate in innovative honors courses and work with faculty and other Honor Scholars to create a vibrant academic community.

Mary Baldwin Global Honors Scholars pledge to enhance their academic experience by taking three Honors courses, writing an Honors senior thesis and taking one year of a foreign language and one lab science course. Freshmen Global Honors Scholars also participate in an intriguing new seminar with actors from the American Shakespeare Center.
