Three important things will take place at registration.

- Student account is checked to make sure it is clear
- A student receives a Housing Priority Point (HPP) ticket
- A student selects a random number, this indicates the order within the HPP Band that they will pick from.

# Overview

The Housing Selection Process consists of two separate events. They are HSP Registration and Room Selection.

This informational guide outlines what happens at both events as well as the “pre-qualification” process that is required of all students.

## Qualifications to Participate

- Pay \$300 deposit
- Cleared student account

## Room Selection: Step by Step

1. Show up at the SAC at your designated night and arrival time, with your MBC ID.
2. Bring you HPP ticket and Proxy form (if needed).
3. Wait until your number is called in the designated waiting area
4. Go to the table of the residence hall for which you wish to select a room.
5. Select a room with your roommate and receive a Room Assignment Receipt.
6. Proceed to check out table to have your assignment recorded and sign an On Campus Housing contract for the 2011-12 year.

# Housing Priority Points

## Class-

- Rising Senior – 6 points
- Rising Junior – 4 points
- Rising Sophomore – 2 points

## Leadership-

- SGA EC – 8 points
- Student Leaders – 4 points
- Academic Excellence
- Global Honors Scholars – 4 points

## Financial Responsibility-

- Pay deposit by 3/1 – 2 points
- Pay deposit by 3/18 – 1 point

## Cumulative GPA-

- 4.0- 3.8 – 10 points
- 3.79- 3.6 – 9 points
- 3.59- 3.4 – 8 points
- 3.39- 3.2 – 7 points
- 3.19- 3.0 – 6 points
- 2.99- 2.8 – 5 points
- 2.79- 2.6 – 4 points
- 2.59- 2.4 – 3 points
- 2.39- 2.2 – 2 points

## Examples

### Student A

- Rising Sophomore – 2 points
- Student Advocate – 4 points
- Has a 2.5 GPA – 3 points

**Total HPP** = 9 points

### Student B

- Rising Sophomore – 2 points
- Student Advocates – 4 points
- Paid on time – 2 points
- Has a 4.0 GPA – 10 points

**Total HPP** = 18 points

**Qualifies for Jump-** -10 points

**Re-Totaled HPP** = 8 points

## The Jump Number

Student B qualifies due to the GPA to “jump” into the next academic classification. Student B now can select a room on junior selection night. However, Student B does not keep the same number of Housing Priority Points as they move into the next classification. That is to say that Student B will not select with the junior 16 band rather Student B will select lower within the junior class.

The Jump number is now “8” which is the sum of all point categories minus the GPA points (10). Student b now get to select on junior night behind all juniors with 9 points or more.
