If you graduated in a year ending in 2 or 7, this reunion is all about you!

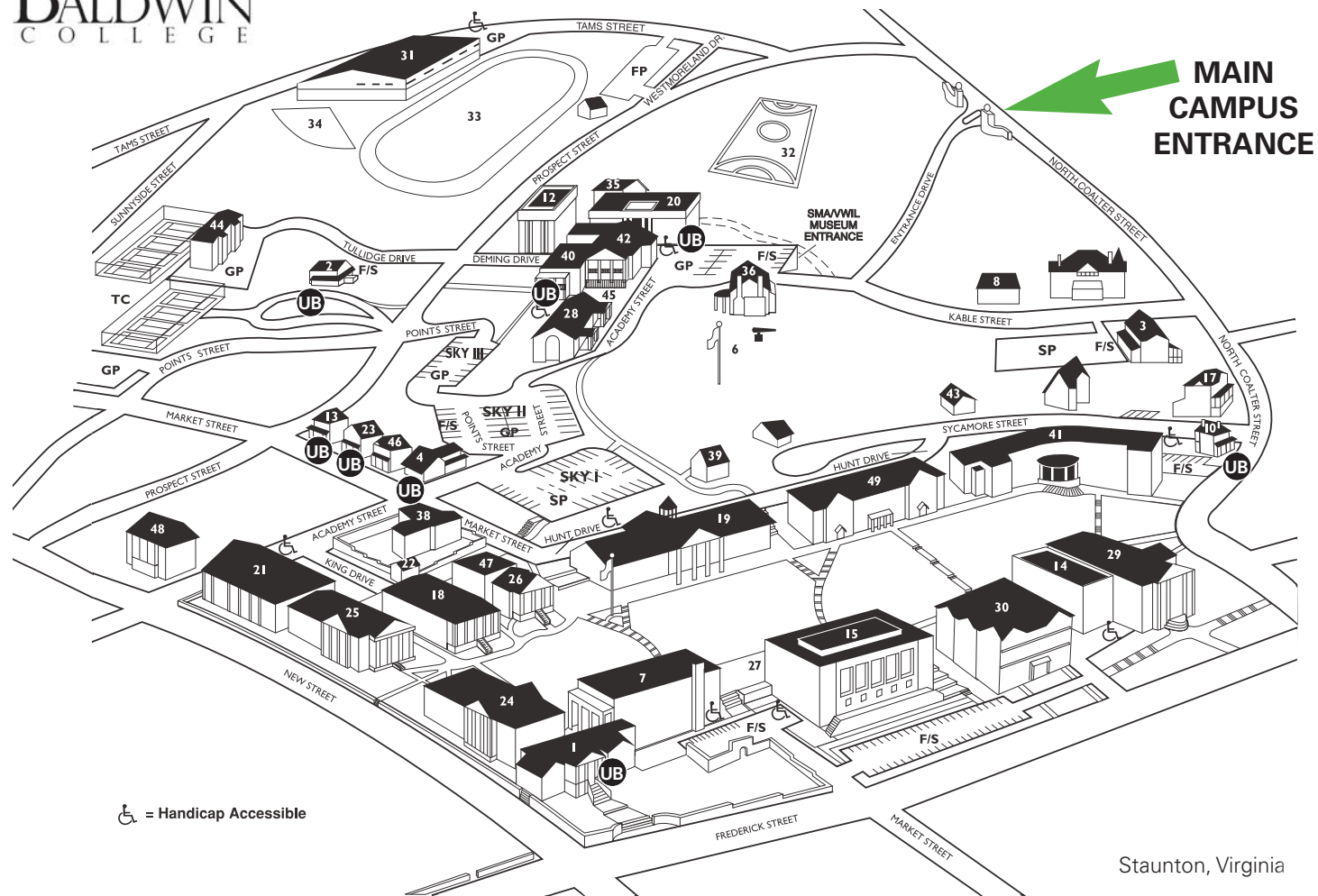
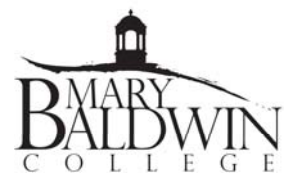
