Study Abroad: Cuernavaca, Mexico!

Tentative Weekend Excursions:

- **1st Sunday: Mexico City Museums** - Museums -Museum of Anthropology, Chapultepec Castle, National Zoo (1 ½ hours away from Cuernavaca)
- **2nd Saturday: Taxco**- A colonial town famous for its silver and architecture (2 hours from Cuernavaca)
- **2nd Sunday: Mexico City South** – Floating gardens of Xochimilco & Frida Kahlo’s Museum, Coyoacán Market (1 ½ hours away from Cuernavaca)
- **3rd Sunday: Puebla** – Colonial city, and a UNESCO World Heritage Center (2 ½ hours away from Cuernavaca)
